Other audience favorites are returning this season, like **Dancing with the Caldwell Stars** (featuring local celebrities!) and **McManus and Me**, a one-man comedy show based on the writings of popular Idaho author, Patrick McManus. "Ever since we presented our last McManus Comedy, I've received emails asking when the next one will be. It's now!" said Assistant Director, Alison Moulton. The family favorites **Clara's Tea Party**, **Nutcracker Jr**, and **Missoula Children's Theatre**, will also continue to delight the little ones.

Sylvia Hunt, Executive Director, is excited to bring back **Repertory Dance Theatre Company** this season. "We've presented this company several times, dating clear back to 1968. They are always an audience favorite." Caldwell Fine Arts also plans to offer new events, such as the exciting group, **VOCO**, an award-winning female *a cappella* group utilizing body percussion. Treasure Valley icons Opera Idaho, Boise Baroque Orchestra, and Ballet Idaho will also present the semi-staged opera, *Orpheus and Eurydice*, for the first time on the Jewett Stage.
